By Water:

- Boat Show Participant - \$75.00 per boat for the day and includes:
 - Slip Rental for the day – Request “D” Dock
 - Entry Fee for competition
 - Free T-shirt
 - Entry into event – additional guests pays \$10.00
 - A really good time and a possible cash prize & trophy
 - Boat Registration & Judging begins at 9 AM. All boats participating in competition must be entered by 1 PM. Judging Criteria is on the next page.

By Land:

- Entry to Event is \$10.00

JUDGING CRITERIA

There will be two open categories of the contest. Each category will be judged separately.

Category 1 – Performance Boats (1st, 2nd & 3rd places)

Category 2 – Cruisers; Fly-bridge and center consoles (1st & 2nd places)

Judging will be performed in 5 categories.

1. Paint job / gelcoat
2. Fabric condition/carpets
3. Compartment(s) condition up to and including heads and galley
4. Polished metals condition
5. Bilge compartment/engines

The mission of the boating event is to come out and have fun and proudly display your boat. The focus of the judging event is to expose the overall appearance, neatness, cleanliness and maintenance of the vessel.

Each judging category (5) has a complete value of 20 points to equal 100 total points. Any deductions in each category will reduce the total point value. Additional values can be achieved in the bonus category. This value is applied depending on the age of the boat.

Deductions will be listed as major or minor infractions. Major infractions are equal to 1pt. (1.0) Minor infractions are equal to ½ pt. (.5). Examples of major infractions will include excessive rusting, paint chips, paint fading, oil leaks and torn or stained fabrics. Examples of minor infractions will include paint scratches, dirt in compartments, and minor rust on screw heads and dirt on fabrics.

✚ TIE BREAKER

If two or more boats are tied for first place, these procedures will be used to break the ties.

1. The higher score in category #1 (Paint job / Gel coat) will be the winner of the tie.
2. If the scores are the same, the next tie breaker will be the highest score in category #5 (Bilge compartment)
3. If the scores are the same, the next tie breaker will be the highest score in category #4
4. Any ties at that point that are unresolved, the final arbitrator will be Richard Turner.

✚ THE JUDGES DECISION WILL BE FINAL

All boats will receive the judging sheets for their boat.

✚ AWARDS

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finalists are based on the criteria above and will receive cash prize and trophy.

✚ JUDGES TROPHY AWARD

- This award is for the overall most unique vessel considering age, condition, and distance traveled.
